

Library Cards

Anyone wanting to check out books, use the internet, and other activities at the library are required to show a BPLS Library or Internet Card.

- Library Cards are free to Beaumont residents
- Non-residents must pay a non-resident fee.
- A current state picture ID along with proof of residency is required to receive a card.
- Non-residents who own property within the city limits of Beaumont may receive a free library card with presentation of a current tax bill.
- Children under 18 must have their parent sign for a card.
- Adults may check out any materials in the library.
- Only adults can check out DVD/Blu Ray discs.
- Address changes must be reported to the library as soon as possible.
- All notices are sent via email. A current email address is required on all applications.
- Lost cards must be reported immediately. A one dollar (\$1) fee is applied for replacement cards.
- All fines must be cleared before a replacement card will be issued.
- All cards expire 5 years after issue.
- Other terms and conditions apply.
